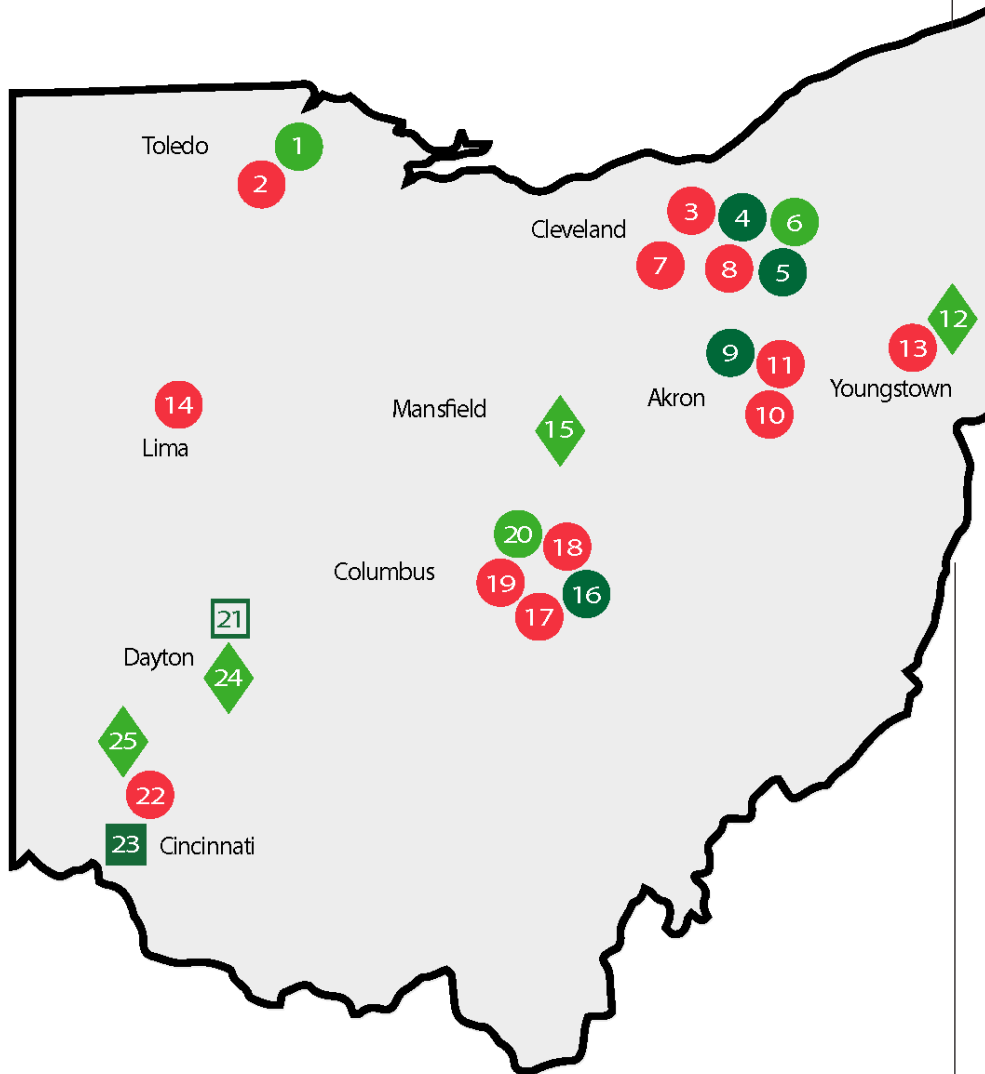

\* SB 127 (2016) bans abortion in Ohio after 20 weeks post-fertilization, or 22 weeks since a pregnant person's last menstrual period. Clinics use last menstrual period dating to establish the dates up to which they will provide abortion services.

\*\* HB 64 (2015) requires clinics to have transfer agreements with hospitals within 30 miles. Clinics seeking a variance or exception to transfer agreement requirements must submit the variance request to the Ohio Department of Health for approval.

\*\*\* Requires in-person counseling/ultrasound at surgical abortion facility.
