Image 1 Doctors, not patients

In Ohio, the six-week abortion ban criminalizes doctors who provide abortions, but not people who have them. @openreprohealth

## Image 2 6 weeks

Many people don't even know they're pregnant by 6 weeks. Even for those who do know, abortions have often happened after 6 weeks. Factors outside a patient's control impact the ability to have an early abortion: structural racism, financial hardship, and more. @openreprohealth
